Eclipse-O-Rama 2024**

Camping Information – Glamping, RVs, Car Camping, and Primitive Tent Camping

All camping reservations must be made either via The Planetary Society's official Eclipse-O-Rama website or the Epic Glamping website. All camping reservations are for a standard three-night stay beginning on Saturday, April 6 through Monday, April 8, with check-out by 11 a.m. on Tuesday, April 9. While all guests may arrive on Saturday, April 6, it is not a requirement and guests may arrive on any day during the three-day period subject to the check-in times noted below. Also note that while camping opens on April 6, official Eclipse-O-Rama programming will not begin until 11 a.m. on Sunday, April 7. Early arrivals are available as a convenience for travelers and offer campers the opportunity to arrive early in Fredericksburg and enjoy other destinations in the area, such as wine tasting, museums, and more.

These rules outlined below apply to guests staying on-site in camping areas (that includes glamping, RVs, car camping, and primitive tent camping), while rules for guests staying in the Country Inn Cottages are set separately by the Country Inn Cottages. **Also, note hotel guests staying with the Country Inn Cottages are subject to a different minimum four-night minimum stay.**

All rules are subject to being updated at the discretion of The Planetary Society and Country Inn Cottages.

General Arrangements:

1. Camping rates are for three nights and are priced as follows:
 - a. Glamping – details and reservations via Epic Glamping (see Eclipse-O-Rama website for details).
 - b. RV boondocking - \$750.00
 - c. Car camping - \$500.00
 - d. Primitive tent camping - \$400.00

2. Upon arrival, campers will check in both for the event as well as their camping reservation. Check-in: Saturday, April 6, 1 p.m. to 9 p.m.; Sunday, April 7th, 9 a.m. – 6 p.m.; and Monday, April 8th, 7 a.m. - 11 a.m.
3. Camping is “primitive” with no water or electricity at the tent sites, though port-a-potties, hand-washing stations, showers, water, and ice are available in designated areas.
4. All camping options include space for one vehicle to park in a designated parking space. RV parking will be approximately 40 by 25 feet; car camping will be approximately 30 by 25 feet, with space behind the vehicle for your tent; glamping and primitive tent camping will have a single, standard parking space.
5. The primitive tent camping is intended for pack-in and pack-out format, and a vehicle unloading will be from your parking spot in the parking area. Tent camping parking areas are within easy walking distance from the tent camping areas.
6. Primitive tent camping will be allowed in specified areas with an allocation of 20 x 20 feet. Occupancy should not exceed 6 persons per campsite. If you have a larger party, please register for more than one site.
7. For car and primitive tent camping, only traditional tents, not exceeding 300 square feet that can be secured to the ground will be permitted.
8. No tents are allowed at RV sites. All tent camping must be in the designated tent camping areas.
9. Car and primitive tent campers must have a tent. Except for RVs, sleeping in vehicles is prohibited.

Camping Rules:

1. Campsites must be kept clean and tidy at all times.
2. No campfires or open flames; only propane stoves and grills are permitted.
3. Absolutely no vehicles, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, trailers, or any other type of motorized or wheeled vessel will be allowed on the ranch outside of the roads and designated parking areas.
4. Recreational drones are permitted though they must be flown in accordance with applicable laws and may not exceed the boundaries of the ranch.
5. While service animals (as defined under the ADA) are permitted, due to liability concerns and logistical issues, we unfortunately cannot allow pets at this event. We will provide referrals to local pet hotels that may provide a solution for members and guests traveling with a pet.
6. Quiet Hours are 10 P.M. until 7 A.M. Please be considerate of others.
7. Smoking is permitted in outdoor areas only and individuals are responsible for the proper disposal of cigarette butts; smoking is discouraged (though not prohibited) in camping areas and encouraged near facilities where there are proper ashtrays. Please be considerate of others when smoking outside and smoke 50 feet away from others.
8. Inflatable pools, hot tubs, or any other container holding larger than a bucket of water are not permitted.
9. No soliciting, peddling, loitering, trespassing, or trading is allowed in the park. The sale

of drugs and alcohol is not permitted on the premises.
