Except where the context otherwise requires, the headings of this Chapter apply only to:

(...)

- (g) The products mentioned in (a), (b), (c), (d), (e) or (f) above with (...) an <u>emetic</u> added to facilitate (...)
- Facilitating identification or for safety reasons
- Substance that causes vomiting

- Placebos and blinded clinical trial kits



- Note 4 to Chapter 30:
 - ✓ for use in recognised clinical trials
 - ✓ put up in measured doses
 - ✓ might contain active medicaments



Placebos

- Designed to mimic a medicament in appearance
- For use in recognised clinical trials
- Generally a pharmaceutically inert product
- Including vaccines used as control substances
- Various forms, such as tablets, liquids, injections and patches

Blinded (or double-blinded) clinical trial kits



- Containing either the trial medicaments, the corresponding placebos or both
- Designed to anonymize the medicament
- May contain any item or packaging necessary solely for the safe transport or storage of the goods
- Fulfilled all relevant regulatory requirements in the country of import



Heading 38.08

- Products intended:
 - ✓ To destroy pathogenic germs, insects, mosses and moulds, weeds, rodents, wild birds, etc.
 - ✓ To repel pests or used for disinfecting seeds
- Anti-sprouting products
- Plant-growth regulators
- Put up in forms or packing for retail sale
- Put up as preparations or articles


- Luminaires: Complete electric light units

 - ✓ To be fitted into a dropped ceiling grid



S-P-F and Hem-fir

4407.13	Of S-P-F (spruce (<i>Picea spp.</i>), pine (<i>Pinus spp.</i>) and fir (<i>Abies spp.</i>))
4407.14	Of Hem-fir (Western hemlock (<i>Tsuga heterophylla</i>) and fir (<i>Abies spp.</i>))

- Subheading Notes 3 and 4 to Chapter 44
- Sourced from mixed stands
- Classification without recourse to GIR 3 (b) or 3 (c)





For babies

96.19 Sanitary towels (pads) and tampons, napkins and napkin liners for babies and similar articles, of any material.

- Deleted: "for babies"
- Simplifying classification of napkins and napkin liners for adults



Temporary canopies/gazebos

- 63.06 Tarpaulins, awnings and sunblinds; tents (including temporary canopies and similar articles); sails for boats, sailboards or landcraft; camping goods.
- Specific type of tent
- Protection against weather elements
- Metal frames
- Roof and sides separately installed





Overlap between 7007.11 and 8708.22?

7007.11	(Toughened safety glass) of size and shape suitable for incorporation in vehicles, aircraft, spacecraft or vessels
8708.22	Front windscreens (windshields), rear windows and other windows specified in Subheading Note 1 to this Chapter

Front windscreens and other windows for vehicles



Subheading 8708.22 covers

- Front windscreens (windshields), rear windows and other windows:
 - framed; or
 - incorporating heating devices or other electrical or electronic devices
 - when suitable for use solely or principally with the motor vehicles of headings 87.01 to 87.05

Front windscreens and other windows for vehicles



- Excluded from Chapter 70
- Front windscreens, rear windows and other windows
- For vehicles of Chapter 86 to 88
- When:
 - ✓ Framed or
 - ✓ Incorporating heating devices or other electrical or electronic devices
