Dual use goods (I)

Provisions in headings:

- 28.44 - items containing radioactive elements and isotopes
- 28.45 - items containing certain isotopes
- 30.02 - vaccines, toxins, cultures of micro-organisms and similar products
- 55.01 - filament tow of aramid
- 81.03 - crucibles of tantalum
- 81.06 - bismuth of high purity

- 81.12 - hafnium and rhenium

Dual use goods (II)

Provisions in headings:

- 84.14 - gas-tight biological safety cabinets
- 84.19 - lyophilisation apparatus, freeze drying units and spray dryers
- 84.28 - industrial robots
- 84.79 - cold isostatic presses
- 85.14 - hot isostatic presses, electron beam furnaces and plasma and vacuum arc furnaces

Dual use goods (III)

Provisions in headings:

- 85.25 - television cameras, digital cameras and video camera recorders, the following:
 - high-speed goods specified in Subheading Note 1 to Chapter 85
 - radiation-hardened or radiation-tolerant goods specified in Subheading Note 2 to Chapter 85
 - night vision goods specified in Subheading Note 3 to Chapter 85
- 90.27 - mass spectrometers

Chemical Weapons Convention

New entries:

Rotterdam Convention



- Multilateral environmental agreement covering trade in certain hazardous chemicals and pesticides
- New entries of chemicals:
 - 2931.54 - trichlorfon (ISO)
 - 2932.96 - carbofuran (ISO)
 - 3824.89 - mixtures and preparations containing short-chain chlorinated paraffins
- Subheading Note 1 to Chapter 38:
 - *trichlorfon (ISO)* and *carbofuran (ISO)* added
 - *penta- and octabromodiphenyl ethers* deleted

International Narcotics Control Board



- Monitoring and control of certain fentanyl-related substances including fentanyl precursors
- 2933.33: carfentanil (INN) and remifentanil (INN)
- 2933.34: other fentanyls and their derivatives
- 2933.36: ANPP
- 2933.37: NPP
- 2934.92: other fentanyls and their derivatives

Heading 36.03 subheadings:

3603.10 - safety fuses

3603.20 - detonating cords

Novel tobacco and nicotine products

- Creating new heading 24.04
- Consequential amendments to the titles of Section IV and Chapter 24

Reason:

- New types of products which differ from traditional tobacco products

Novel tobacco and nicotine products

24.04 Products containing tobacco, reconstituted tobacco, nicotine, or tobacco or nicotine substitutes, intended for inhalation without combustion; other nicotine containing products intended for the intake of nicotine into the human body.

- Products intended for inhalation without combustion :

2404.11 -- Containing tobacco or reconstituted tobacco

2404.12 -- Other, containing nicotine

2404.19 -- Other

- Other:

2404.91 -- For oral application

2404.92 -- For transdermal application

2404.99 -- Other

Novel tobacco and nicotine products

New Notes 2 and 3 to Chapter 24 :

- 2.- Any products classifiable in heading 24.04 and any other headings of the Chapter are to be classified in heading 24.04.
- 3.- For the purposes of heading 24.04, the expression ‘inhalation without combustion’ means inhalation through heated delivery or other means, without combustion.

Novel tobacco and nicotine products



New subheading 8543.40:

8543.40 - Electronic cigarettes and similar personal electric vaporising devices

Heading 44.12 (I)

- Laminated veneer lumber:

4412.41 - - With at least one outer ply of tropical wood

4412.42 - - Other, with at least one outer ply of non-coniferous wood

4412.49 - - Other, with both outer plies of coniferous wood

LVL:

- Thin veneers, bonded together under heat and pressure
- Re-glued
- Grain is running parallel to longitudinal axis

Heading 44.12 (II)

- Blockboard, laminboard and battenboard:

4412.51 - - With at least one outer ply of tropical wood

4412.52 - - Other, with at least one outer ply of non-coniferous wood

4412.59 - - Other, with both outer plies of coniferous wood

- Other:

4412.91 - - With at least one outer ply of tropical wood

4412.92 - - Other, with at least one outer ply of non-coniferous wood

4412.99 - - Other, with both outer plies of coniferous

Heading 44.18

- Engineered structural timber products:

4418.81 - - Glue-laminated timber (glulam)

4418.82 - - Cross-laminated timber (CLT or X-lam)

4418.83 - - I beams

4418.89 - - Other

- Products consisting of laminated timber or a combination of wood products, such as timber, laminated veneer lumber, plywood or Oriented Strand Board (OSB)
- To provide greater strength than just sawn timber

Textile fabrics laminated with plastics

New Note 3 to Chapter 59:

For the purposes of heading 59.03, ‘textile fabrics laminated with plastics’ means products made by the assembly of one or more layers of fabrics with one or more sheets or film of plastics which are combined by any process that bonds the layers together, whether or not the sheets or film of plastics are visible to the naked eye in the cross-section

Shirts, shirt-blouses and blouses

New Notes to Chapters 61 and 62:

- Shirts (men and women) and shirt-blouses (women):
 - Designed to cover the upper part
 - Having long or short sleeves
 - A full or partial opening at the neckline
 - May have a collar
- Blouses (women):
 - Loose-fitting
 - Designed to cover the upper part
 - May be sleeveless
 - With or without an opening at the neckline
 - May have a collar

New subdivisions:

- Mechanically bonded mats
- Chemically bonded mats
- Mechanically bonded fabrics
- Chemically bonded fabrics
- Glass wool and articles of glass wool
- Comprehensive descriptions in Explanatory Note and Subheading Explanatory Notes

3D printing

- Heading 84.85 :

Machines for additive manufacturing

- New Note 10 to Chapter 84 :
 - 10.- For the purposes of heading 84.85, the expression “additive manufacturing” (also referred to as 3D printing) means the formation of physical objects, based on a digital model, by the successive addition and layering, and consolidation and solidification, of material (for example, metal, plastics or ceramics).

Smartphones

- Heading 85.17: reference to “smartphones” in heading text
- New subheadings:
 - 8517.13 – Smartphones
 - 8517.14 – Other telephones for cellular networks or for other wireless networks
- Note 5 to Chapter 85:
 - Telephones for cellular networks
 - Equipped with a mobile operating system designed to perform the functions of an adp machine
 - Whether or not integrating other features such as digital cameras and navigational aid systems

LED light sources (I)

- Heading 85.39: light-emitting diode (LED) ~~lamps~~ light sources
- 8539.51 - - Light-emitting diode (LED) modules
- 8539.52 - - Light-emitting diode (LED) lamps
- Note 11 to Chapter 85:
 - Light-emitting diode (LED) modules
 - Light-emitting diode (LED) lamps

LED light sources (II)

Light-emitting diode (LED) modules:

- Electrical light sources based on light-emitting diodes (LED)
- Mounted on a printed circuit board or otherwise connected
- Arranged in electrical circuits and containing further elements like electrical, mechanical, thermal or optical elements
- Contain discrete active or discrete passive elements, or articles of heading 85.36 or 85.42 for the purposes of providing power supply or power control
- Do not have a cap for fixing in a lamp-holder
- May have electric connectors

LED light sources (III)

- Light-emitting diode (LED) lamps:
- Electrical light sources containing one or more LED modules
- Containing further elements like electrical, mechanical, thermal or optical elements
- May have heat sink or rectifier

Distinction between light-emitting diode (LED) modules and light-emitting diode (LED) lamps:

- Lamps have a cap (e.g., screw, bayonet or bi-pin type) for fixing in the lamp-holder

E-waste

- New heading 85.49 :

Electrical and electronic waste and scrap

- New Note 6 to Section XVI (extract) :

Electrical and electronic assemblies, printed circuit boards, and electrical or electronic articles :

- Rendered unusable for their original purposes; or
- Economically unsuitable for repair, refurbishment or renovation to render them fit for their original purposes; and
- Packaged or shipped in a manner not intended to protect individual articles from damage

E-waste

Including :

- Waste or scrap of primary cells, primary batteries or electric accumulators (currently 8548.10);
- Spent primary cells, primary batteries or electric accumulators (currently 8548.10);
- Consumer electronics;
- Office, information and communication technology devices;
- Household appliances;
- Power tools;
- Electrical or electronic parts, including printed circuit boards

Electric vehicles (1)

Further subdivision of subheading 8701.20 (“road tractors for semi-trailers”) :

- With only compression-ignition engine
- With both compression-ignition engine and electric motor as motors for propulsion
- With both spark-ignition engine and electric motor as motors for propulsion
- With only electric motor for propulsion
- Other

Electric vehicles (2)

Restructuring subheadings of heading 87.04 :

- With only compression-ignition engine
- With only spark-ignition engine
- With both compression-ignition engine and electric motor as motors for propulsion
- With both spark-ignition engine and electric motor as motors for propulsion
- With only electric motor for propulsion

Unmanned aircraft

New heading 88.06 :

Unmanned aircraft

New Note 1 to Chapter 88 :

- Designed to be flown without a pilot on board;
- May be designed to carry a payload; or
- May be equipped with permanently integrated digital cameras or other equipment which would enable them to perform utilitarian functions during their flight;
- Other than flying toys designed solely for amusement purposes

Low volume of trade (I)

Thresholds:

- Heading: 100 million USD
- Subheading: 50 million USD

Exceptions:

- Structure
- Good of environmental or social concern
- Of particular interest for a developing country
- At special request of any Contracting Party
