


# Single Window stages of implementation per WCO region in 2019





- Scan Risks & Threats: unacceptable risks and single point of failure
- Know your "water": BIA
- Plan for continuity: MAO; RTO
- Design BC measures, **resource requirements** (buildings, people, ICT, suppliers, equipment, etc.) and **structures**
