## Export Restrictions in Raw Materials Trade: Facts, fallacies and better practices



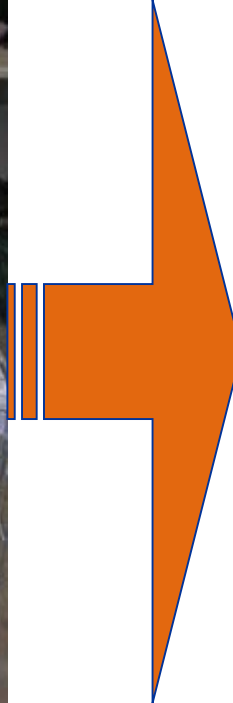
In 2021, approximately 927 million tons of recyclable commodities were traded around the world, valued at approximately \$191 billion.

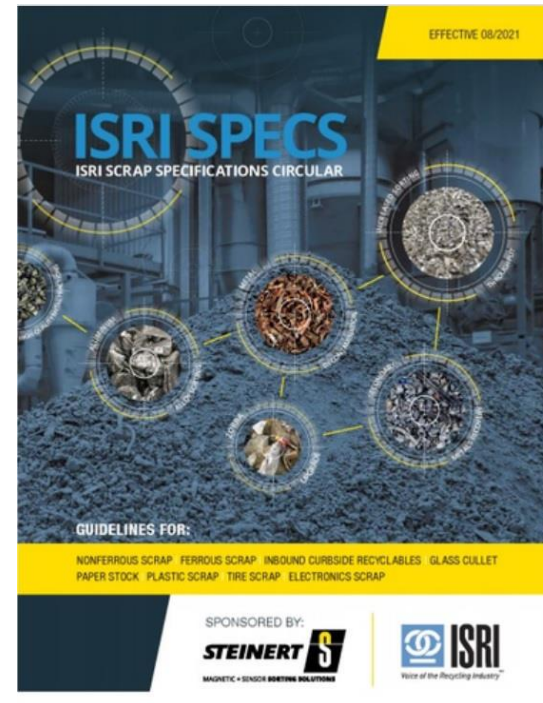
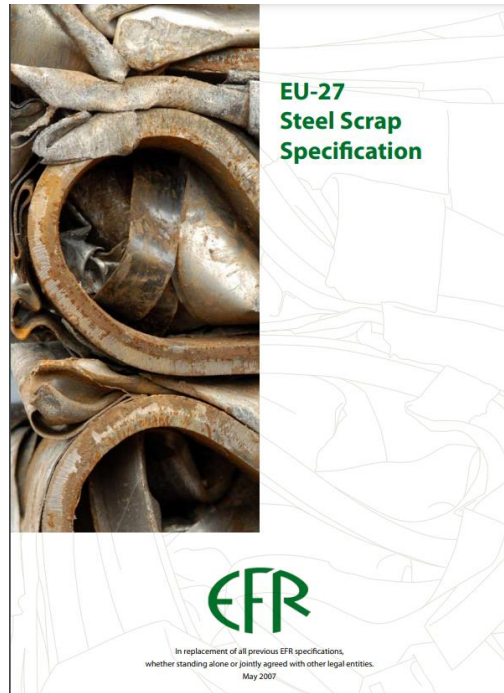

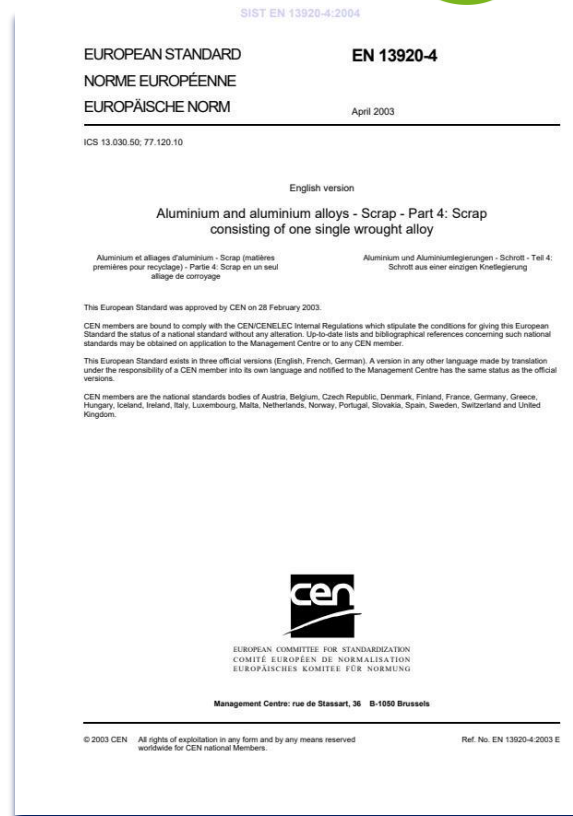
