












The global plastic waste trade market is remarkably **complex**...





This creates significant opportunities for illegal traffic...


- Concealment
- Misdeclaration
- Transshipment



Plastic waste is particularly difficult to control...



- Sheer volumes traded annually.
- **Highly heterogenous** source of waste.
- Lack of sufficient guidance on identifying illegadifficult to identify contamination as well as hazardousness).
- Lack of alignment of HS codes to distinguish wastes I shipments (e.g. extremely with different control procedures under Basel convention.



So what can customs do?







- **1. Align HS codes** to distinguish wastes with different control procedures under Basel.
- Encourage strong deterrent penalties for false declarations of HS codes.
- **3. Stronger cooperation** between Agencies.
- 4. Work with **NGOs and industry**
- **5. Improving enforcement,** especially in exporting countries.
- 6. On general terms, we need **much** stricter penalties for environmental crimes.
