

Stephanie Lee is a Member, Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center and Professor, University of Washington. She holds the David and Patricia Giuliani/Oliver Press Endowed Chair for Cancer Research and is an NIH-funded clinical investigator whose research interests include health services/outcomes research, quality of life/patient reported outcomes, and allogeneic hematopoietic cell transplantation with a special interest in chronic graft-versus-host disease (GVHD). She is the Principal Investigator of the Chronic GVHD Consortium, a group of US institutions that collaborate to conduct observational and therapeutic trials of chronic GVHD. She has published over 450 articles in peer-reviewed journals and is a member of American Society for Clinical Investigation and the Association of American Physicians. Dr. Lee also holds a number of leadership positions including Associate Director of the Clinical Research Division and Research Director of the Transplant Long-Term Follow-Up Program at Fred Hutchinson and Co-Scientific Director of the Immunobiology and GVHD Working Committees of the Center for International Blood and Marrow Transplant Research. She was the 2020 President of the American Society of Hematology.
