



2023 Field Trip

Revitalising British Wool to meet Climate+ Goals, hosted by Pilio



The focus of this Field Trip will be to discuss and demonstrate how we can revitalise British wool to support the meeting of the Textile Exchange Climate+ goals. The event will be held at an Organic and Pasture for Life-certified farm which is proactively improving space for nature. During the day, we will have three themes of focus:

1. Farmer investment - discussing farmer opportunities for carbon sequestration and nature recovery illustrated through the farm system, implemented, and documented through the science. This will include discussion on traceability technology, monitoring, and reporting.
2. Sourcing sustainable wool - discussing the desirability of wool and brand demand, and the availability and sourcing of British regenerative and recycled wool.
3. New financial models - Discussing the shift in British farming policy incentivising new financial mechanisms such as inseting and blended finance to deliver environmental improvement at a landscape scale.

Field Trip Location: Manor Farm, Chearsely, Buckinghamshire, UK **Duration of Tour:** 1 Day

Date of Field Trip: Friday, October 27

Arrival Details: Arrive by 10am via Public transport – train from London, which is 40 minutes on the Chiltern Trainline followed by a 10-minute taxi to the farm. Sufficient taxis will be available.

Departure Details: Depart for London after 4pm.

Who can attend? Anyone is welcome.

Cost to Attendees: *150 USD

What is included:

- Food and drink during the tour.

Attendees are responsible for:

- Train ticket from and to London (Round Trip).
- Taxi from the station to the farm (this can be shared if multiple are traveling together).
- Lodging (if required), meals, incidentals, etc. that fall outside of the tour.
