The Microfibre Consortium - Fibre Fragmentation from Textiles in Action



This field trip hosted by The Microfibre Consortium (TMC) will welcome delegates to increase awareness and learn about fibre fragmentation and its environmental impact. It will also provide an opportunity to see a behind-the-scenes laboratory view of the TMC Test Method to measure fibre fragmentation from fabrics. Delegates will witness first-hand, the scientific measurement of microfibre loss widely adopted across the industry by signatories of The Microfibre 2030 Commitment.

Field Trip Location: London, UK

Duration of Tour: Half Day

Date of Field Trip: Friday, October 27

Arrival Details: A short tube ride from Greenwich station on the Jubilee Line to Waterloo station. Two tour options: 10am and 2pm.
