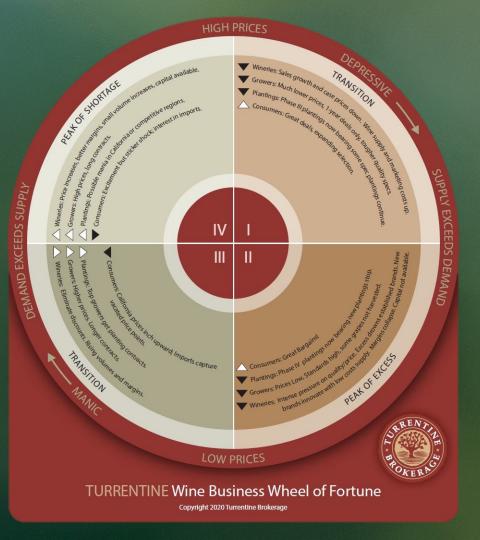

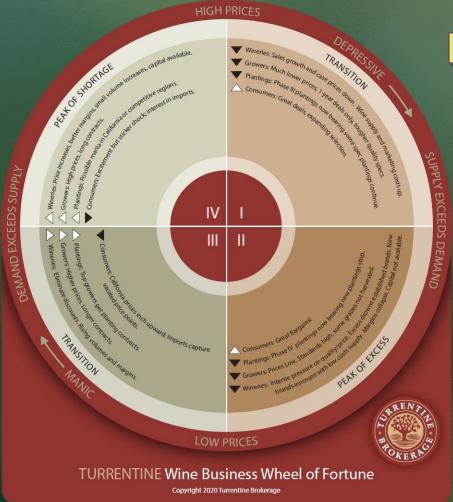

- Sales growth since 90's
- White to red
- Premiumization shift, NI & Coastal
- Higher production vineyards
- Difficult to change bottle price



Recent Challenges

- Light yields and short crops
- Acres removed in the Southern interior
- Escalation of grape & bulk price
- Consumer channel shifting to retail and now back
- Challenging Economic climate
- Actions and variable lags possible



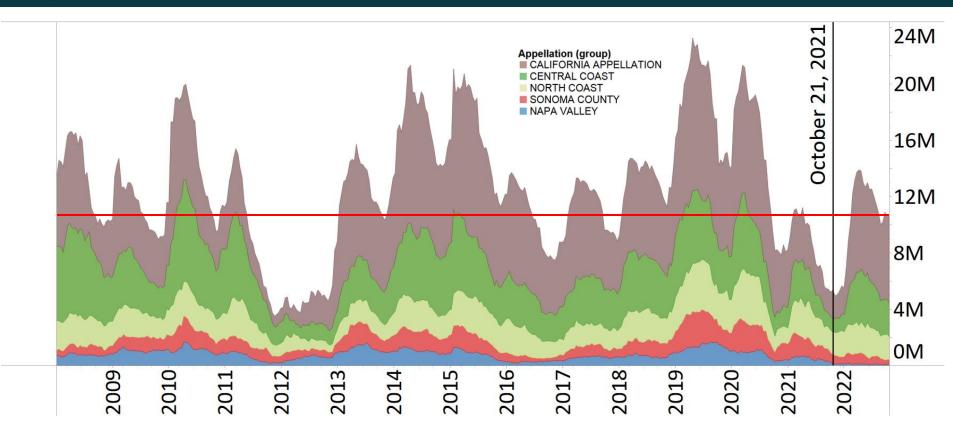
2022 Projected Tons Crushed

Cabernet Sauvignon

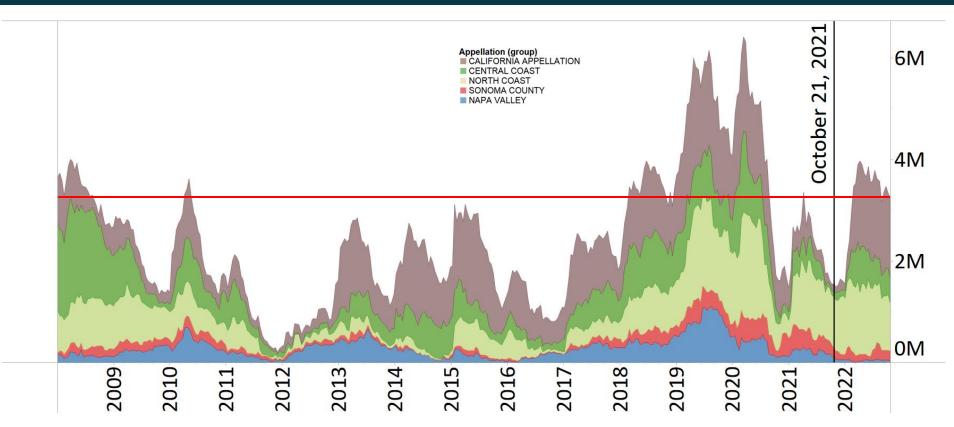


Cabernet Sauvignon Recent Tons Crushed & 2022 Projection

Cabernet Sauvignon Takeaways

- Luxury
 - Price escalation \rightarrow variable lag
- Premium
 - 2022 less excess grapes and price improved, but grapes available late
- Value
 - Buyers to sellers of bulk wine and price softened
 - Excess grapes not purchased



Chardonnay

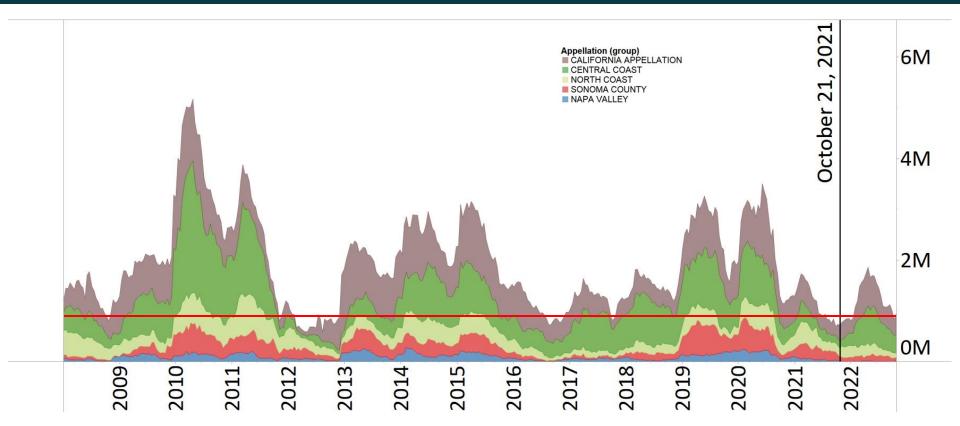


Chardonnay Recent Tons Crushed & 2022 Projection

Chardonnay Takeaways

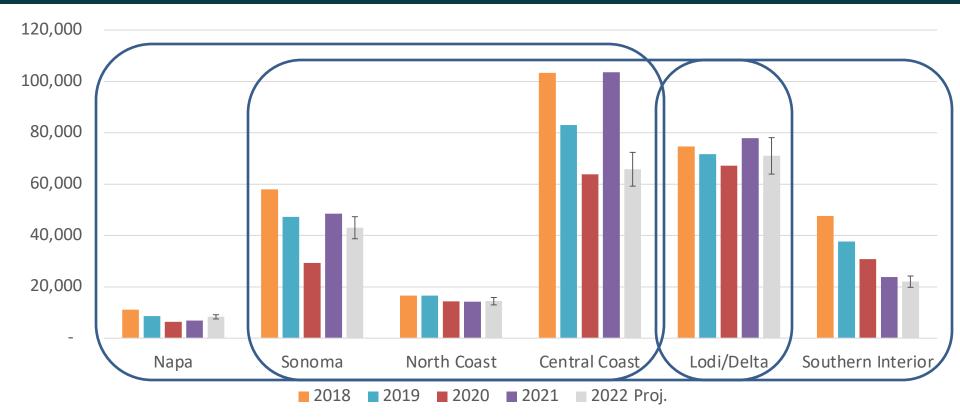
- Luxury
 - Escalation of price \rightarrow variable lag
- Premium
 - Bulk wine and grapes available most of the year, grapes purchased late due to light crop
- Value
 - Supply short and Demand price sensitive



Pinot Noir

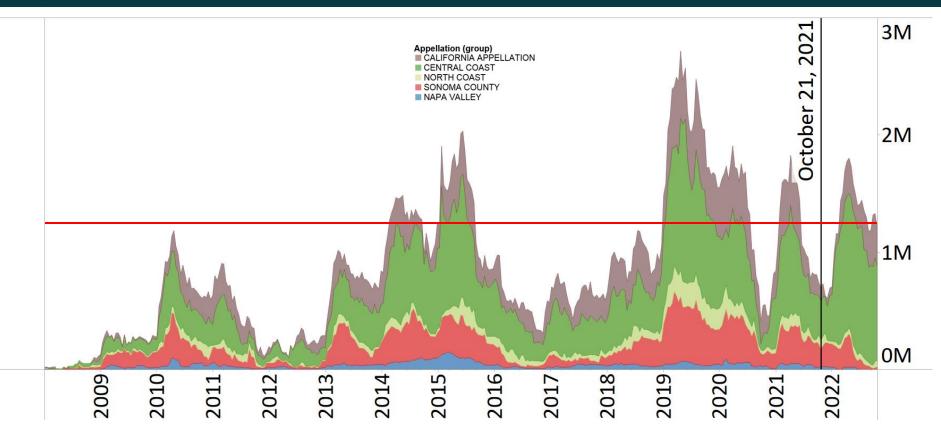


Pinot Noir Recent Tons Crushed & 2022 Projection

Pinot Noir Takeaways

- Luxury
 - Short crop in RRV and Son County
 - Escalation of price is softening bulk demand
- Premium
 - Bulk supply available and demand soft
- Value
 - Bulk and grapes available all year and acres are still not in full production

Sauvignon Blanc

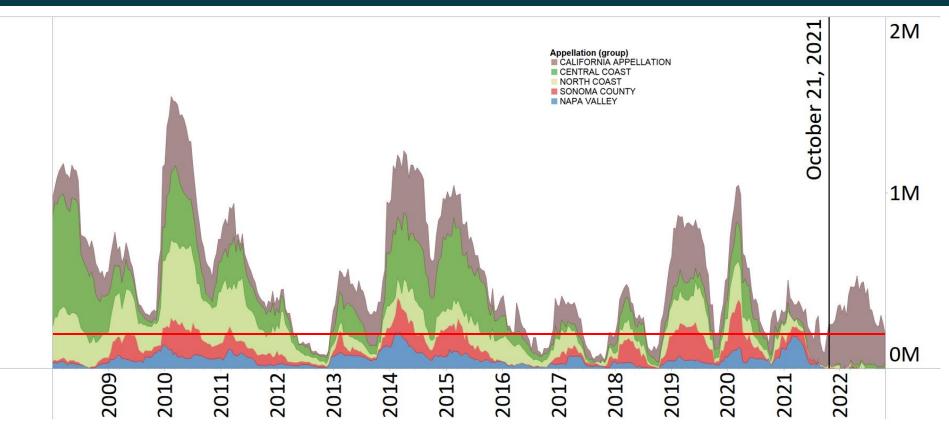


Sauvignon Blanc Recent Tons Crushed & 2022 Projection

Sauvignon Blanc Takeaways

- Luxury
 - 3rd light year
 - Price escalation
- Premium
 - Broad demand for supply in all regions
- Value
 - Oversupply of 2021 bulk wine



Summary

- Harvest not a lot of uniformity in yields 3rd year in a row
- Market more balanced due to short term supply not Consumer Demand
- Challenges to costs of operation and inflation for all
- Escalation of price \rightarrow variable lag
- Not in an over supply in the short term
