

Update in Non-neoplastic Hematology

HELP IMPROVE AWARENESS REGARDING RECENT PROGRESS!

Non-neoplastic hematologic disorders include all blood conditions that are not malignant, such as cytopenias, anemias, and thrombocytopenias. These disorders range from mild to severe and are associated with heterogeneity, variable responsiveness to treatment, and rarity.

The term "benign" to describe non-neoplastic hematologic disorders is considered a misnomer since several life-threatening and devastating disorders are encompassed within this spectrum such as:

- · Refractory Autoimmune Hemolytic Anemia
- · Severe Immune Thrombocytopenia (ITP)
- · Acquired Hemophilia
- Thrombotic Thrombocytopenic Purpura (TTP) or Catastrophic Antiphospholipid Antibody Syndrome

Non-malignant blood disorders are currently evaluated and managed by hematologists who are also trained in oncology and have their clinics located in Cancer Centers. A recent survey has shown that referral of patients with non-neoplastic hematologic disorders to a Cancer Center is associated with increased stress and anxiety among patients. Importantly, many patients could perceive that they were referred for evaluation of a cancer diagnosis and hence reported that they would prefer to be referred to a hematology clinic not located in a Cancer Center (Curley BF, et al. Blood. 2013;122(21):2952-2952).

Recent data continue to show that there is a need to improve the workup, diagnosis, and management of non-neoplastic hematologic disorders. Clotting disorders, bleeding disorders, anemias, and thrombocytopenias are associated with a poor quality of life and several unmet medical needs. The field of non-neoplastic hematology is in need of healthcare practitioners who will further impact and improve management of these disorders.

Although malignant hematologic disorders gain more attention, non-neoplastic, or benign hematologic diseases are also associated with challenges in terms of diagnosis, management, and poor outcomes. Notably, the optimal management approach varies greatly based on the kind of disorder and its underlying cause and severity. Recent years have witnessed several advances in non-neoplastic hematology with:

- · Identification of novel mechanistic pathways
- · Diagnostic approaches
- · And updated treatment algorithms

In light of these developments, the workup and management of non-neoplastic hematologic disorders have become all the more complex, and busy healthcare professionals continue to face difficulties staying abreast of recent progress.
