A roundish mound of caramel, marshmallow nougat, fresh roasted peanuts, and a real mil chocolate that today is known to all as the “Go Goo Cluster” When in Nashville, it is nearly impossible not to see these sweet treats throughout the city—and once you try one, event more impossible not to get hooked! 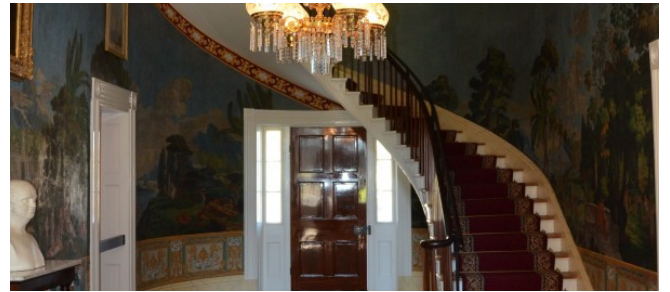

Southern Mansion Tour

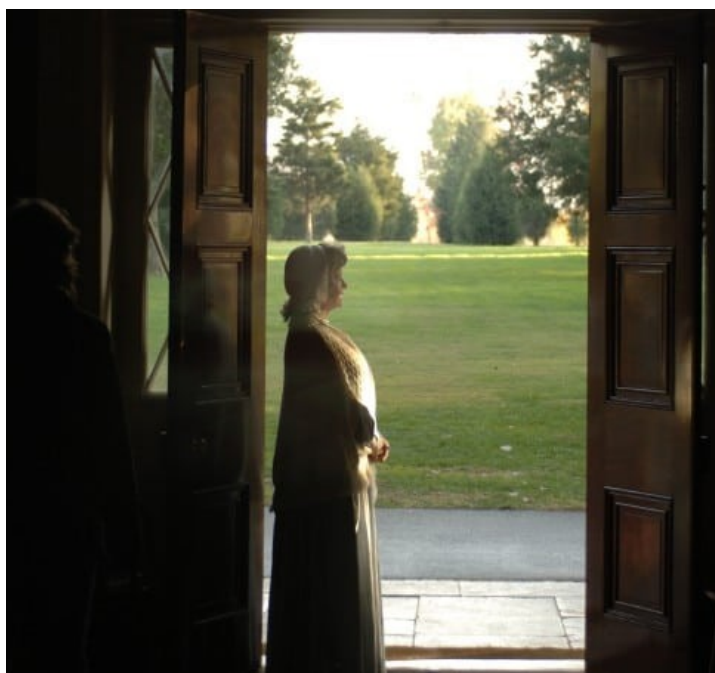

Country Music Hall of Fame



The **Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum** in Nashville, Tennessee, is one of the world's largest museums and research centers dedicated to American vernacular music. Chartered in 1964, the museum has amassed one of the world's most extensive musical collections. Known as the "Smithsonian of Country Music" this museum and self-guided tour will give guests a glimpse into the past of country music and the people behind its success. Also included in this activity is **RCA Studio B**, a music recording studio, which was an essential factor to the development of the production style and technique known as the "Nashville Sound". Beyond the countless recordings made by legendary music artists here, Elvis Presley is known to have made more than two hundred song recordings at this location.
