LITHIUM BATTERY COURSE SYLLABUS

GENERAL INFORMATION

DESCRIPTION

The DOT and IATA set forth detailed training requirements to reduce and prevent hazmat incidents both domestically and internationally. Violations of these regulations, including training requirements, are subject to civil penalties for violations and more stringent penalties for violations that result in death, serious illness, or severe injury to any person or substantial destruction of property.

Hazmat training is one of the requirements for which the DOT sets a minimum penalty for noncompliance, per violation.

EXPECTATIONS AND GOALS

This course will provide the requisite understanding and general principles behind the required training topics in the 49 CFR and IATA, including *general awareness*, *function-specific training*, security awareness, and safety *training*. The focus of this course will be to highlight the growing regulations regarding the safe transportation of lithium batteries.

The course is designed to focus on cultivating a general knowledge of the rules and regulations involving the air and ground transportation of lithium batteries, and how to utilize the proper regulations in order to prepare compliant lithium battery shipments for transport.

This course will also provide an overview of UPS specific policies regarding the transport of lithium batteries.

*No prior knowledge and hazmat experience is required to complete this course.
