ABSTRACT SCORING CRITERIA

INDICATORS:

- A. Clear research question: Is there are clear research question, aim or hypotheses?
- B. Quality: If an **empirical** study, the research design is of high quality and sufficiently explained, including clearly stated data sources, data collection procedures, and analytic approach If a **conceptual** study, the conceptual framework is of high quality and sufficiently explained, including integration of topic into current thinking, clear exposition of treatment of topic, and meaningful connections to the relevant research communities. If a **case** study / series, the importance of the case for the wider SCI community is clearly stated, including case presentation, data collection methods, and analytic approach.
- C. Novelty: Does the abstract demonstrate clinical, methodological, translational, and/or basic science innovation.
- D: Importance / contribution: Demonstrate how scientific knowledge will be gained (should be gained) from the study, and the authors must specify how the paper will contribute to the development of local or global knowledge
