Our Services

The Foundation focuses primarily on the stewardship of church resources:

INVESTMENT SERVICES

Providing options for churches and related entities to pool their funds in professionally managed investment services adhering to United Methodist Social Principles. We serve ministries, endowments, trustee funds and other permanent funds.

PLANNED GIVING

Educating the church community about planned giving options and programs. We assist individuals who **want to share their life's blessings** with the church.

STEWARDSHIP SERVICES

Providing education and consultation to local churches. We hold workshops and retreats as well offer one-on-one assistance to churches. Check out our summer retreat at Pine Lake in August!

CONGREGATIONAL LOANS

Offering first mortgages to churches to help them grow in ministry and maximize their resources.

CAPITAL CAMPAIGNS

Foundation Ministries

The Wisconsin United Methodist Foundation has been blessed by donors who have established funds allowing us to provide gifts and support to local churches and individuals.

GRANT PROGRAM

Providing seed money to churches that are starting new and creative ministries. In the spring and fall we award grants to deserving churches to help them in new ministries.

GENERAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Providing scholarships to students attending college and vocational schools. Each spring the foundation award \$500 to \$1,500 scholarships to deserving United Methodist students.

SEMINARY SCHOLARSHIPS

Providing scholarships to certified candidates for ministry who are attending a UM approved seminary.
