

Information on abstract submission format

- The official language of the conference is English; only abstracts submitted in English will be accepted.
- The abstract maximum is 250 words (not including abstract title and titles for images/diagrams/etc.)

Abstract Content

- Structure is as follows:
 - o **Submission Topic** (see description below)
 - o **Abstract number** (will be assigned automatically)
 - o **Abstract title**
 - o **Author names* First name(s) and last name(s)** (do not add titles)
 - o **Author affiliations*** including country, of each author. Author affiliations should be indicated by superscript numbers, e.g. Felix Moran¹, Jim Bradley²
¹University of Ulster, N. Ireland; ²Belfast City Hospital, N. Ireland.
 - o **Content (max. 250 words, excluding abstract title)**
The abstract content should be structured using the following headings:
 - For original work: Background, Aims, Methods/Techniques, Results/Outcome, Conclusions
 - For case reports: Background, Case History, Conclusions
 - o **Keywords (max. 5 words)**

**Missing/incomplete details will not be queried and will be published as is.*

Figures & Tables

- Any abbreviations should be defined where first mentioned
- We accept the following figure formats: .jpg, .jpeg, .png
- Figures will be published as per the resolution of the figure provided (minimum 300 dpi is recommended)
- Regardless of whether figures are submitted in colour or mono, figures will be printed in mono
- Figure and Table legends should be editable and appear in the abstract text under the figure/table.

Submission Topic

- Please allocate your Abstract to one of the following 11 topics

A: Pathogenic mechanisms	G: Genetic testing and counselling
B: Models for HD	H: Clinical care and clinical services
C: Genetic modifiers	I: Experimental therapeutics - preclinical
D: Wet biomarkers	J: Clinical therapeutics
E: Imaging	K: other
F: Clinical studies: case reports, observational studies and trials	
- **Define up to 5 Keywords** for your Abstract. These will be used to build a subject index.

Editing

- Abstracts will undergo pre-editing but not copyediting.
- Obvious mistakes will be corrected and the abstracts will be amended to house style as appropriate.

Licence to publish

- Authors of all abstracts are required to grant an exclusive licence on a worldwide basis to the BMJ and/or co-owners or contracting owning societies (where published by the BMJ on their behalf) in accordance with the BMJ standard licence. Therefore, **accept the licence during the abstract submission process on the platform (this is mandatory)**.

Notification of accepted Abstracts and poster presentations

- Abstracts will be reviewed by the review committee. All abstracts approved by the review committee are accepted for the poster exhibition on site in Strasbourg and will be published in a supplement of the Journal of Neurology, Neurosurgery and Psychiatry (JNNP). You will be notified early July whether your abstract has been accepted for publication or not.
- Particularly good abstracts/posters are considered for an oral presentation live at the EHDN and Enroll-HD 2024 in the therefore dedicated Sessions.
