3. RED LIGHTS MEAN STOP

Motorists who are careless put riders in danger. We can do better for our children by not driving aggressively, watching for upcoming school zones and not texting and driving while focusing on the road.

In Pennsylvania, motorists must stop at least 10 feet away from school buses that have their red lights flashing and stop arm extended. Motorists must stop when they are behind a bus, meeting the bus or approaching an intersection where a bus is stopped.
