2023 Credit Union Legislative Issues

PUBLIC DEPOSITS

- The Federal Credit Union Act (FCUA) authorizes all federall chartered credit unions
 to accept public deposits, but Florida law does not grant state governmental
 entities the authority to deposit funds in either federally chartered and/or statechartered credit unions. Currently, 33 states have some sort of public deposit
 authority for credit unions. Expanding public deposits authority to credit unions
 would spur competition and lead to public entities earning more income on their
 decreasing deposits of public funds.
- LSCU asks legislators to support the passage of House Bill 987 by Representative
 Adam Botana and Senate Bill 1360 by Senator Blaise Ingoglia. HB 987 has passed
 the House Insurance and Banking Subcommittee and is awaiting a hearing in the
 House State Administration & Technology Appropriations Subcommittee. SB 1360 is
 awaiting a hearing in the Senate Committee on Banking and Insurance.

INTERCHANGE FEES

- Recently, there has been a significant federal effort to regulate interchange fees.
 Financial institutions remain responsible for fraud and data security losses that stem from breaches caused by retailers that do not secure their payment data.
 Interchange fees cover the cost of fraud detection, credit monitoring, fraudulent purchase protection, and more. State-level legislation has been introduced in the past, prohibiting card-issuing financial institutions from charging interchange fees on the sales tax portion of a retail transaction.
- The LSCU opposes legislation that alters credit card interchange fees. Instead, the LSCU encourages data security legislation that protects consumer data and encourages merchants to accept more transaction liability. Please ask legislators to oppose House Bill 677 by Representative Mike Caruso and Senate Bill 564 by Senator Travis Hutson.

PACE LOAN PROGRAM

- In 2010, the Legislature approved the use of Property Assessed Clean Energy (PACE) loans for use to improve homes for energy efficiency and wind resistance. A property owner could borrow money up front to do the improvements and a lien is recorded upon the property and paid off through increased property assessments.
 - These liens then take priority over the mortgage, due to it being a tax lien.
- This year's bill changes the name to the Resiliency Energy Efficient Florida program (REEF). It would add consumer protections, including underwriting and income requirements, credit checks, financing estimate disclosures and several other protections to ensure consumers understand the process of repayment and are able to fulfil these requirements.
- While LSCU continues to oppose this program due to the lien priority over the mortgage, we do support the proposed consumer protections in these bills.
 Support House Bill 669 by Representative Randy Fine and Senate Bill 950 by Senator Ana Maria Rodriguez so long as they do not expand the program to support other improvements such as septic-to-sewer conversions, sea wall repair or expansion, etc.

He then went on to earn his Law Degree from Harvard Law School in 2008 before moving to Florida in 2010 where he served as a law clerk to a Federal District Judge. He is still a practicing attorney by trade, and he is happily married to his wife Hope. The couple have two young sons, Michael and Ross. Mike is also an Eagle Scout and takes pride in this formative experience he had growing up. He has been recognized as a Outstanding Young Florida Lawyer and has been

appointed by Governors Rick Scott and Ron DeSantis to the Judicial Nominating Commission for Florida's Thirteenth Circuit Court in Hillsborough County. Mike was first elected to the Florida House in 2018 and was reelected subsequently in 2020 and 2022. Mike is a passionate fighter in the courtroom and in the legislature for the causes he believes in and is grateful to his constituents for the opportunity to serve.

Bill Berg, VP of Compliance Training and Information, LSCU & Affiliates



Bill Berg has been with the League of Southeastern Credit Unions (formerly the Florida Credit Union League) since 1988 and currently serves as the vice president of compliance training and information. In this position, Bill answers technical/regulatory questions; provides customized training to credit unions, chapters, and other groups; and facilitates planning sessions for credit unions. A life-long resident of Pasco County, Danny was elected in 2020 to represent District 20 in the Florida Senate. He currently chairs the Senate Judiciary Committee and has previously served as Chair of the Select Committee on Pandemic Preparedness and Response as well as the Chair of the 2022 Senate Legislative Redistricting Committee. No stranger to difficult issues and heavy workloads, Danny fights tirelessly for his legislation and his District. During the 2022 Legislative Session, Danny was able to pass 17 pieces of legislation that were then signed into law by Governor DeSantis, the most of any member in the legislature. He is an attorney by trade

and is a Partner at the law firm of Shumaker, Loop and Kendrick, LLP, and prides himself on being more than just a lawyer; he is also a father, husband, soldier, and public servant.

Senator Blaise Ingoglia, Florida State Senator, Commerce Chair (R-Hernando)



Blaise Ingoglia is a small business owner and conservative champion who is not afraid to take on the establishment and fight for our families. First elected to the Florida House in 2014, Blaise quickly established himself as a conservative leader. Today, he serves as Chairman of the House Commerce Committee. In the House, Blaise maintained his commitment to conservative principles, standing strong against tax increases, illegal immigration, and efforts to weaken our Second Amendment rights. Corey Simon, Florida State Senator (R-Tallahasse)



Corey Simon is a resident of Tallahassee, a former professional football player and current president of the Big Bend Pop Warner football league. He attended high school in Pompano Beach before attending Florida State University on a football scholarship where he was a consensus All-American his senior year and helped the Seminoles to the 1999 BCS National Championship. The Philadelphia Eagles then selected Simon with the 6th overall pick in the 2000 NFL Draft. He would go on to amass 246 career tackles, 32 sacks and 9 forced fumbles over eight seasons with Philadelphia, Indianapolis and Tennessee. Following his time in the

NFL, he shifted his focus to philanthropic work and started Corey's Kids, an organization which focused on mentoring children in North Florida's foster care system. He has also partnered with Big Bend Community Based Care for mentoring and coached high school football at Maclay School while being actively involved with Engage Church in Tallahassee. Simon earned his bachelor's degree in information studies from Florida State University.

Russell Weigel, Commissioner, Florida Office of Financial Regulation



Commissioner Weigel is an AV-rated securities attorney, with more than 30 years of legal experience, and a published author. In 2005, he founded a securities transactional and litigation law firm, which he ran until he became commissioner in March 2020. 
Shuttle Schedule:
